TOP 10 THINGS TO BRING to Tour de Cure on Sunday April 27th

- **10.** Your completed Waiver / Emergency Information Form. (If under 18, form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian)
- 9. Your collection envelope containing any donations by check or cash. (Please convert cash or coins to a check payable to the American Diabetes Association.
- 8. Your helmet. No helmet, no ride!
- 7. A well-tuned bike. Pack a spare-tube, patch kit, pump and tire tools.
- 6. A well-trained body and any medications or diabetic supplies you will need. Carry your personal ID and insurance cards and remember to bring all medication you will need during the day.
- 5. Clothing appropriate for the weather. We ride rain or shine!
- 4. A water bottle and a second bottle for sports drink to ensure you stay well-hydrated. Don't wait to hydrate!
- **3.** A parent or guardian if you're under 18. Minors must be accompanied by an adult at all times. This includes riding in a SAG vehicle.
- **2.** \$200** or more turned in on or before the day of the Tour de Cure in order to participate. (Plus reg. fee)
- 1. Excitement for the ride and the great impact you're making to Stop Diabetes!

Parking:

A special \$8 Tour de Cure reduced rate is available at the Queen Mary. Please follow signs and directions from parking volunteers and take a parking ticket. After you have parked, proceed to our check-in area, or if you used Advanced Check-In, then go straight to The Queen Mary Park for a complimentary breakfast.

Please Remember:

- All riders must leave on time per your route departure time.
- Bring a helmet.
- Obey all rules of the road.
- Follow all directions from Law Enforcement and Tour Volunteers.
- Stop at all Stop Signs and Red or Amber traffic signals. When a rider ahead of you passes through a Stop Sign, do not assume it is safe for you to do so. Stop and check in all directions for traffic
- Ride Single File Only.
- Pass on the left and only when safe.
- Be respectful of the neighborhoods you are passing through.

Advance Check-In & Packet Pick-Up

Avoid the lines at your Ship to Shore Tour de Cure 2014 on the morning of April 27th by going to one of four different locations for Advanced Check-In/Packet Pick-Up.

Please select one of the following Advanced Check-In sites that works best for you. Please note that each location has a specific date and time when Advanced Check-In will take place. Please arrive at each location at least 10 minutes before closing so that we have time to process you.

Medtronic, Northridge

Tues, April 22, 2014. 5:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. Packet pickup will be inside the main lobby. 18000 Devonshire Street, Northridge, CA 91325

From 405 Freeway exit Devonshire and head West. Travel down Devonshire for 3 miles. After you pass Zelzah Avenue, Medtronic will be on the left.

Stan's Bike Shop, Monrovia Thurs, April 24, 2014. 4:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. Packet pickup will be inside the bike store. 880 South Myrtle, Monrovia, CA 91016, 626-357-0020

Exit 210 Freeway at Myrtle, head north. Bike shop is on the right at Chestnut Ave.

Two Wheels One Planet, Costa Mesa Weds, April 23, 2014.. 4:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.

Exit end of 55 Freeway to Newport Beach Blvd, head south/east and make a left on 17th St. After you pass Tustin St, Two Wheels One Planet will be on your left.

Queen Mary, Long Beach Sat, April 26, 2014. 11:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Packet pickup will be in the Park.

What to bring to Advanced Check-In and Packet Pick-Up

1. Your signed Emergency Information Waiver Form

To download an Emergency Information Waiver form, please go to your local webpage <u>www.diabetes.org/shiptoshoretourdecure</u> and you will find it under <u>Welcome to</u> <u>the 2014 Ship to Shore</u>. Please print and fill out.

If you are also picking up for team members or other individual riders, you <u>MUST</u> have a signed waiver for <u>EACH</u> rider in order for us to assign a rider bib. All minors (anyone under 18 as of April 27, 2014) must have a waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian.

2. A minimum of \$200 in donations

If you or a rider you are picking up a bib for have collected online and reached \$200 less than 5 days prior to your chosen packet pick-up date, please bring a copy of your and any fellow rider's web-page to ensure we can issue a rider bib. If you have checks or cash to submit, please bring those items with you and read section 3.

3. Your collection envelope

Please place checks or cash inside your collection envelope, note the amount of each donation on the back and your total donations contained in the envelope on the front. If you do not have a collection envelope, one will be available for you to fill out when you arrive at Advance Packet Pick-up.

4. Red Riders

If you are a Red Rider — any rider with diabetes Type 1 or Type 2 — you can collect your Red Rider Cycling Jersey at Advance Packet Pick-Up. If you are collecting on behalf of a Red Rider, please know their jersey size. (Red Riders must meet minimum fundraising requirements and have signed a waiver to receive a Red Rider Jersey)

5. Registering at Advance Pick-up?

If you have not yet registered for Tour de Cure Ship to Shore and wish to do so at Advance Packet Pick-Up and receive your rider bib, you must provide a minimum of \$225 (\$25 registration fee plus \$200 in funds raised). We accept Master Card, Visa, American Express, check or cash.
